Directions to Centre Africa – 20 Plantation Road, Bedfordview

From N3 NORTH

Take the Van Buuren Off ramp and turn LEFT into Van Buuren Road

At the robot (there is a garage on the corner) turn LEFT into Kloof Road.

Travel along Kloof, over the highway and turn LEFT into Talisman Avenue

Go up Talisman to a T junction.

Turn left into Plantation Road

Go to the end (almost) of Plantation Road – heading back towards the highway – Center Africa is on your RIGHT at 20 Plantation Road

From N3 SOUTH

Take the Van Buuren Off ramp.

At the robot intersection with Van Buuren Road, go straight over the intersection into Van der Linde Road.

The first street to your right is Plantation Road - turn RIGHT.

Go to the end (almost) of the road towards the highway – Center Africa is on your RIGHT at 20 Plantation Road

NB:

The Conference venue is on the premises of Rtn Jeremy Webb of the Bedfordview Rotary Club.

As you go through the gates, turn right and park on the tennis court. The conference centre is on your left.
